

HISTORY OF "WHITE LAKE INN"

- Feb. 16, 1855 Peter voorhies purchased the property from the U. S. Government.
- March 8, 1888 Peter Voorhies to Arvilla Voorhies.
- Feb. 26, 1897 Arvilla Voorhies to Carl S. Voorhies.
- March 30, 1899 Carl S. & Millie Voorhies to Jacob & Phebe Smith.
- Feb. 6, 1919 Jacob Smith to Lewis E. Adams who constructed the White Lake Inn that year. He died Dec. 28, 1928.
- Oct. 4, 1922 Lewis & Beryl Adams to Harvey & May Belle Wilson.
- Oct. 28, 1922 Harvey & May Belle Wilson Quit Claim Deed to Lewis & Beryl Adams after a Lis Pendens Lawsuit was filed.
- August 17, 1932 Beryl Adams Quit Claim Deed to Robert & Dorothy Percival.
- May 17, 1934 Beryl Adams Plaintiff Vs. Percivals in a Lis Pendens Lawsuit.
- Sept. 1, 1934 First State & Savings Bank of Holly received a Sheriffs Deed for a consideration of \$700.75. I can't find any owners until May 1942.
- May 22, 1942 Willard & Estelle Dawson received an administrators Deed from the estate of Clifford L. Kenny deceased.
- Sept. 28, 1943 Willard & Estelle Dawson recorded a Warranty Deed.
- August 11, 1948 Willard & Estelle Dawson to Arlie C. & Irma C. Becker.
- Oct. 10, 1959 Arlie Becker sold the business only, on a Chattle Mortgage to Lloyd & Anne Bluhm.
- Oct. 6, 1961 Lloyd Bluhm sold his Chattle Mortgage to James & Donald Osborne.
- Nov. 1964 A fire destroyed a large portion of the kitchen and floor and the hallway leading upstairs. James & Donald Osborne then moved the license to a building on Dixie Highway near M-15.
- Mr. Becker repaired the building and without a license he rented the building out for private parties. One summer it was rented out as a Teen-age Nite Club, known as Mr. Lucky's.
- 1970 Mr. Becker applied for a new license, after the Census was taken, and was issued a new license in the fall of 1971. He was going to re-open the bar in the spring of 1972 but had to have open heart surgery in Miami, Florida so his son in law and daughter, Don & June Cotcher opened and operated the bar from April 1972 until November 1977. Due to ill health they decided to sell.
- Nov. 7, 1977 Don & June Cotcher to Mary "Alice" Gohl who subsequently sold the White Lake Inn to McMullen & Crozier.
- Dec. 27, 1982 Mary Alice Gohl to Mario & Jacqueline Gougeon. They renamed it the White Lake Landing.
